In accordance with our online Terms and Conditions, it's your responsibility to keep up to date with, and adhere to, the policies posted here. Exceptions to these policies are permitted only with authorization from NETADS (www.cpm-ad.com).

Invalid Clicks & Impressions

Publishers may not click their own ads or use any means to inflate impressions and/or clicks artificially, including manual methods. Clicks on NETADS (www.cpm-ad.com) ads must result from genuine user interest. Any method that artificially generates clicks or impressions on your NETADS (www.cpm-ad.com) ads is strictly prohibited. These prohibited methods include, but are not limited to, repeated manual clicks or impressions, automated click and impression generating tools and the use of robots or deceptive software. Please note that clicking your own ads for

any reason is prohibited.

Encouraging clicks

Publishers may not ask others to click their ads or use deceptive implementation methods to obtain clicks. Copyrighted material

Traffic sources

NETADS (www.cpm-ad.com) ads may not be placed on pages receiving traffic from certain sources. For example, publishers may not participate in paid-to-click programs, send unwanted emails or display ads as the result of the action of any software application.

To ensure a positive experience for Internet users and NETADS (www.cpm-ad.com) advertisers, sites displaying NETADS (www.cpm-ad.com) ads may not:

Do NOT click on your own ads. Do NOT ask others to click on your ads. Do NOT modify the NETADS (www.cpm-ad.com) ad code in any way. Do NOT place more than 3 ads per page.
